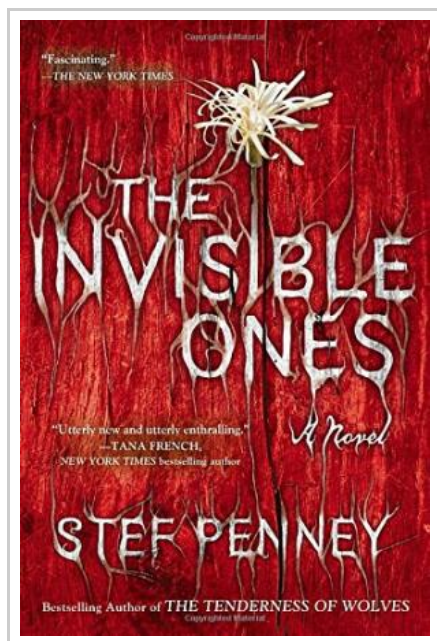




The Invisible Ones
